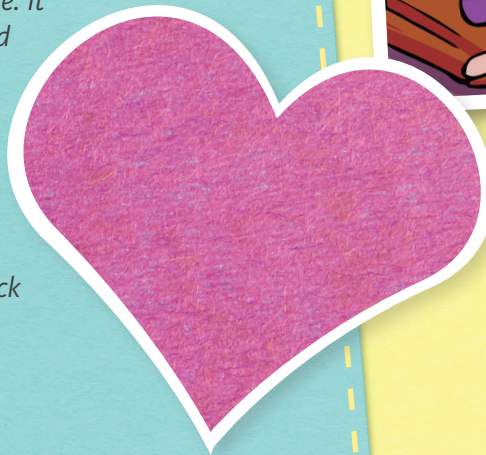
What You Heard *In the Word*

OutWord *For Family Discussion*
