





even death on a cross!

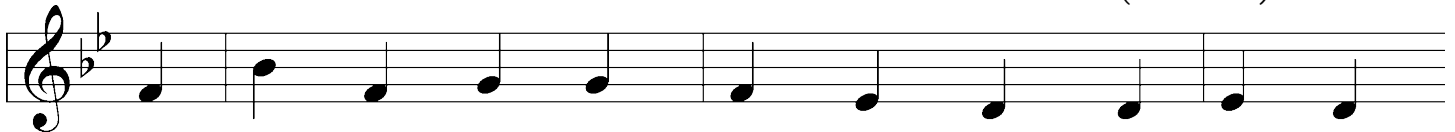
