ORGAN FUND – We are now receiving donations for improvements to our pipe organ. Gifts may be made online, by check payable to “Trinity Lutheran Church” (please note “*Organ Fund*” on the memo line), or by scanning the QR code on the preservice slide or lobby monitor. Our goal is to raise \$26,500.00, which represents 50% of the total cost. As of June 1st, we have received \$22,411.00. We will continue to gratefully accept donations even after this goal has been reached.

YTD FINANCIAL UPDATE – Weekly tithes and offerings support the ongoing expenses of ministry through our congregation. Each week, \$5,800.28 is needed to fund planned ministries for 2026. Year-to-date, \$154,820.75 has been received toward our year-to-date goal of \$162,407.84. ***For the calendar year 2026, our tithes and offerings are \$7,587.09 below our budget needs.*** “*Each of you has been blessed with one of God’s many wonderful gifts to be used in the service of others.
